Boom Extensions for davits and cranes—

A boom extension is a simple and cost effective way to increase the total reach of your MarQuipt davit or crane for lifting lighter weight objects. Using the extension trades increased boom length for a lower weight-lifting capacity.

A boom extension is frequently used to reach a small personal watercraft or scooter stowed alongside the primary tender. Boom extensions can also be helpful for lowering equipment through engine room hatches or spare props over the stern.

Slip-on style boom extensions— (shown top right)

- Simply slips over the end of the boom when needed.
- No modification of the davit required.
- Stows separately- bring it out only when extended reach is needed.

Tenderlift Classic (1000 LB capacity davit)



Tenderlift 2 (1500 LB capacity davit)

+32" @ 0°	1000 LBS (455 KG)
+48" @ 30°	1000 LBS (455 KG)


Fold-under style boom extensions-(shown bottom right)


Fold-under extensions are permanently attached to the davit and stow conveniently beneath the boom when not needed. For davits of up to 1700 LBS lifting capacity, fold-under and slip-on boom extensions work equally well, and the choice between them is primarily determined by stowage and for installation considerations. Fold-under extensions are the only option with larger cranes, where the increased size and weight of the extension itself makes a slip-on extension impractical.

 Maximum extension length and lifting capacity is dependent on the davit or crane model and the extension type.
